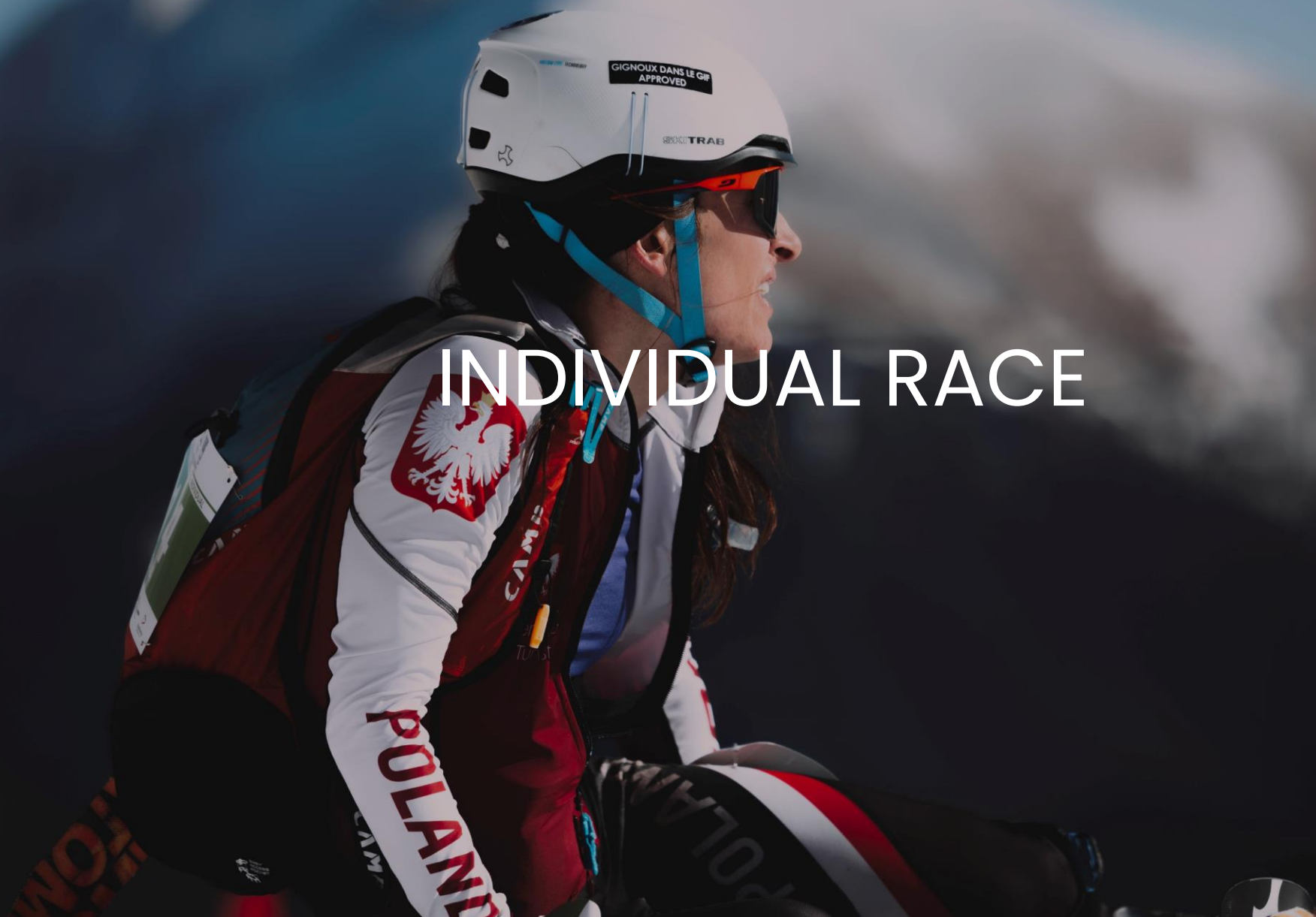



Snowpack

Danger Patterns dp.5: snowfall after a long period of cold dp.6: cold, loose snow and wind

The new snow and wind slabs of the last few days are lying on the unfavourable surface of an old snowpack in particular on shady slopes at elevated altitudes.

Avalanche prone weak layers exist in the old snowpack especially on little used shady slopes.

Sunny slopes:

The snowpack will be in most cases well bonded. As a consequence of low temperatures and low relative humidity a crust will form on the surface during the course of the night. The solar radiation will give rise as the day progresses to increasing moistening of the snowpack on steep sunny slopes. Below the tree line only a little snow is now lying.

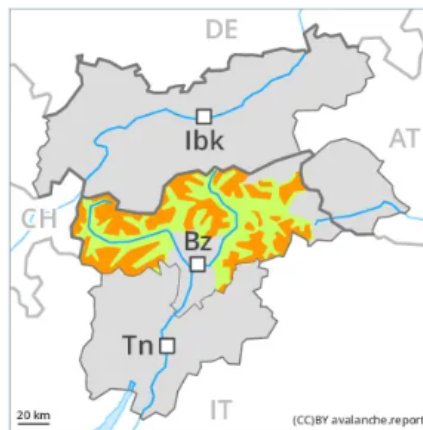
Tendency

The weather conditions will facilitate a stabilisation of the snowpack. Wind slabs and weakly bonded old snow require caution.

Weakly bonded old snow requires caution. Fresh wind slabs at elevated altitudes.

Shady slopes:

Avalanches can in some places be released by a single winter sport participant. The avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular on little used slopes above approximately 2200 m and in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain.

The number and size of avalanche prone locations will increase with altitude. Individual avalanche prone locations are to be found also on sunny slopes in high Alpine regions.

Avalanches can in some cases release deeper layers of the snowpack and reach quite a large size.

Sunny slopes:

As a consequence of warming during the day and the solar radiation, the likelihood of moist loose snow slides being released will increase a little.

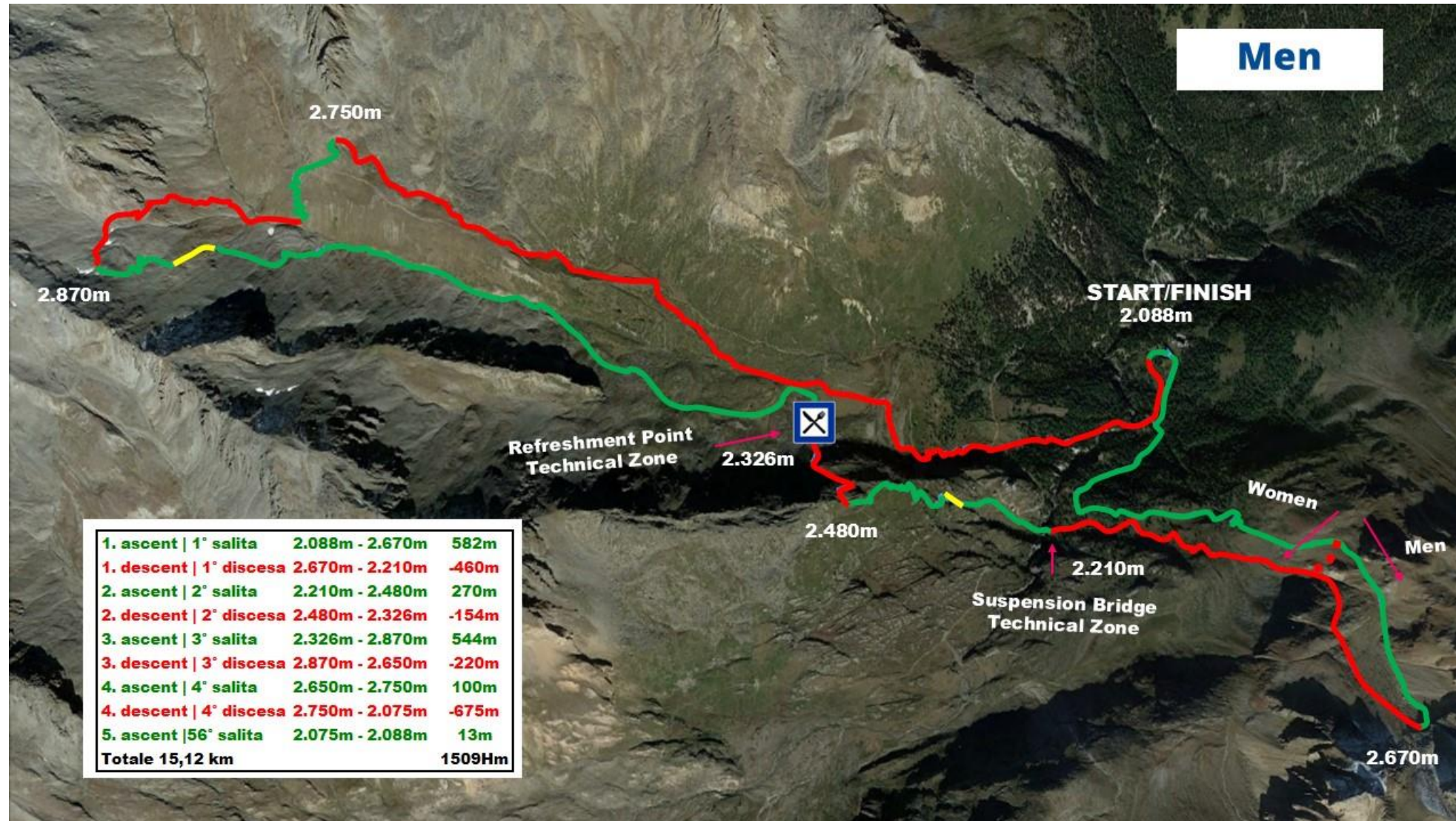

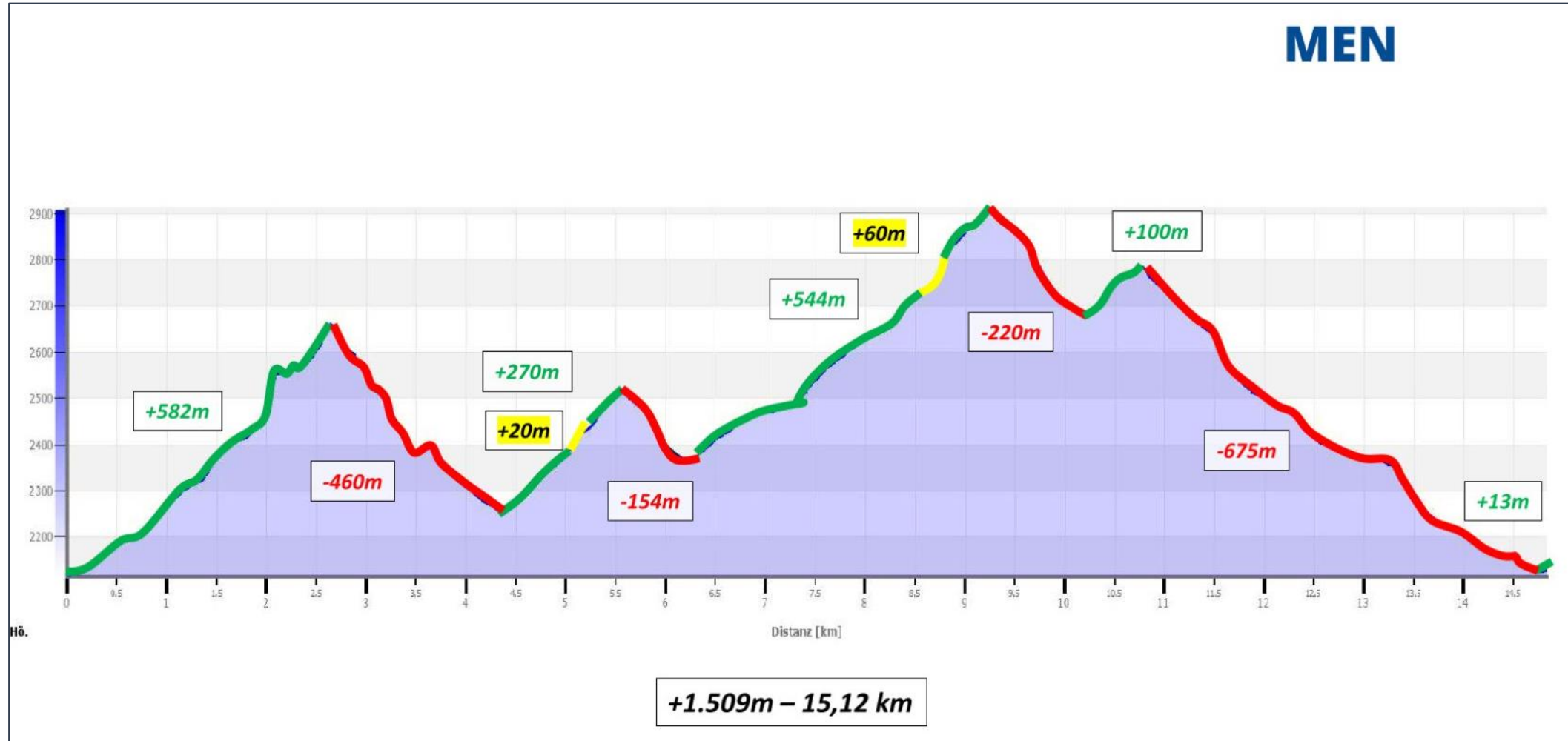

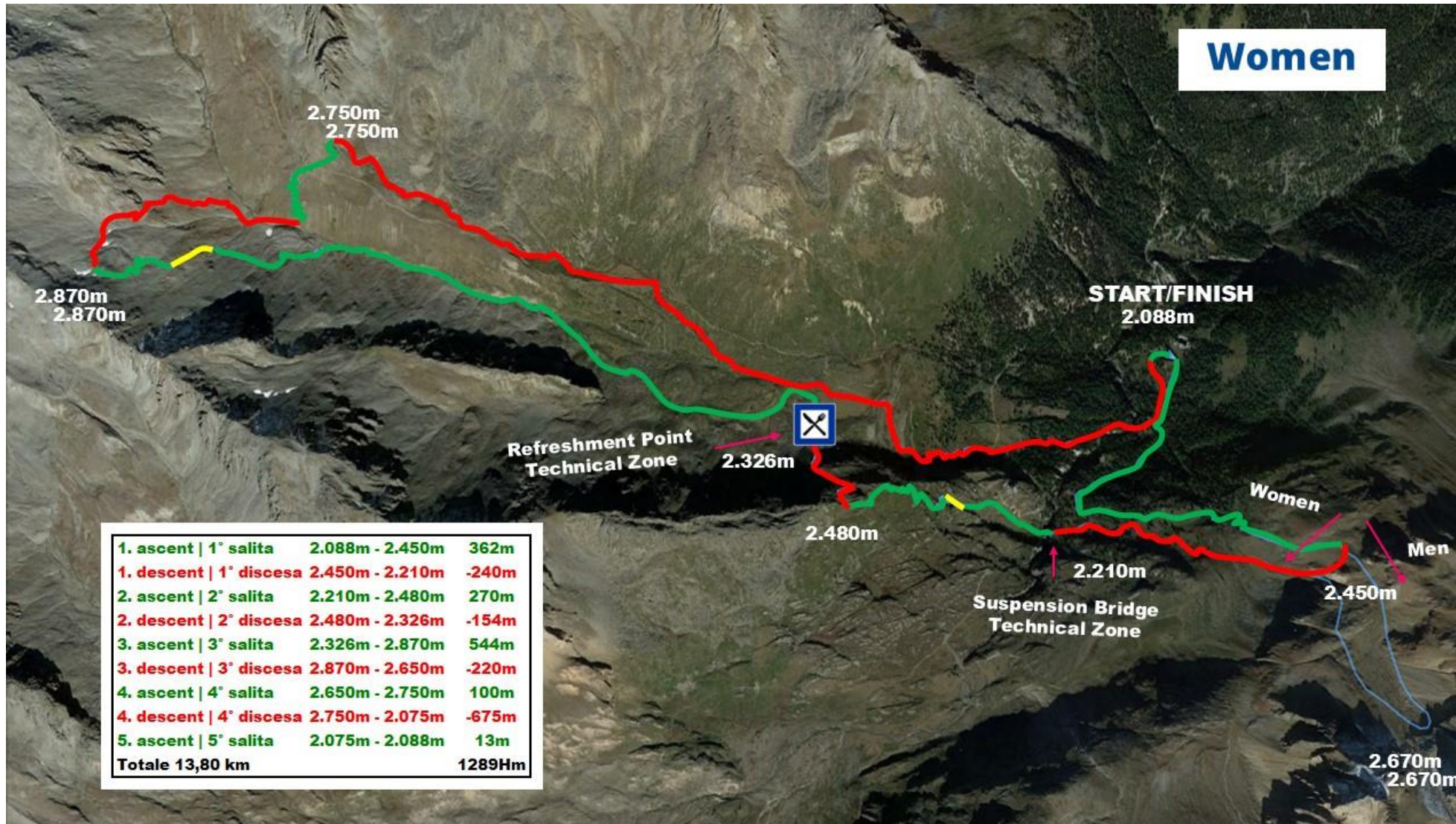
Map and track – Senior Men

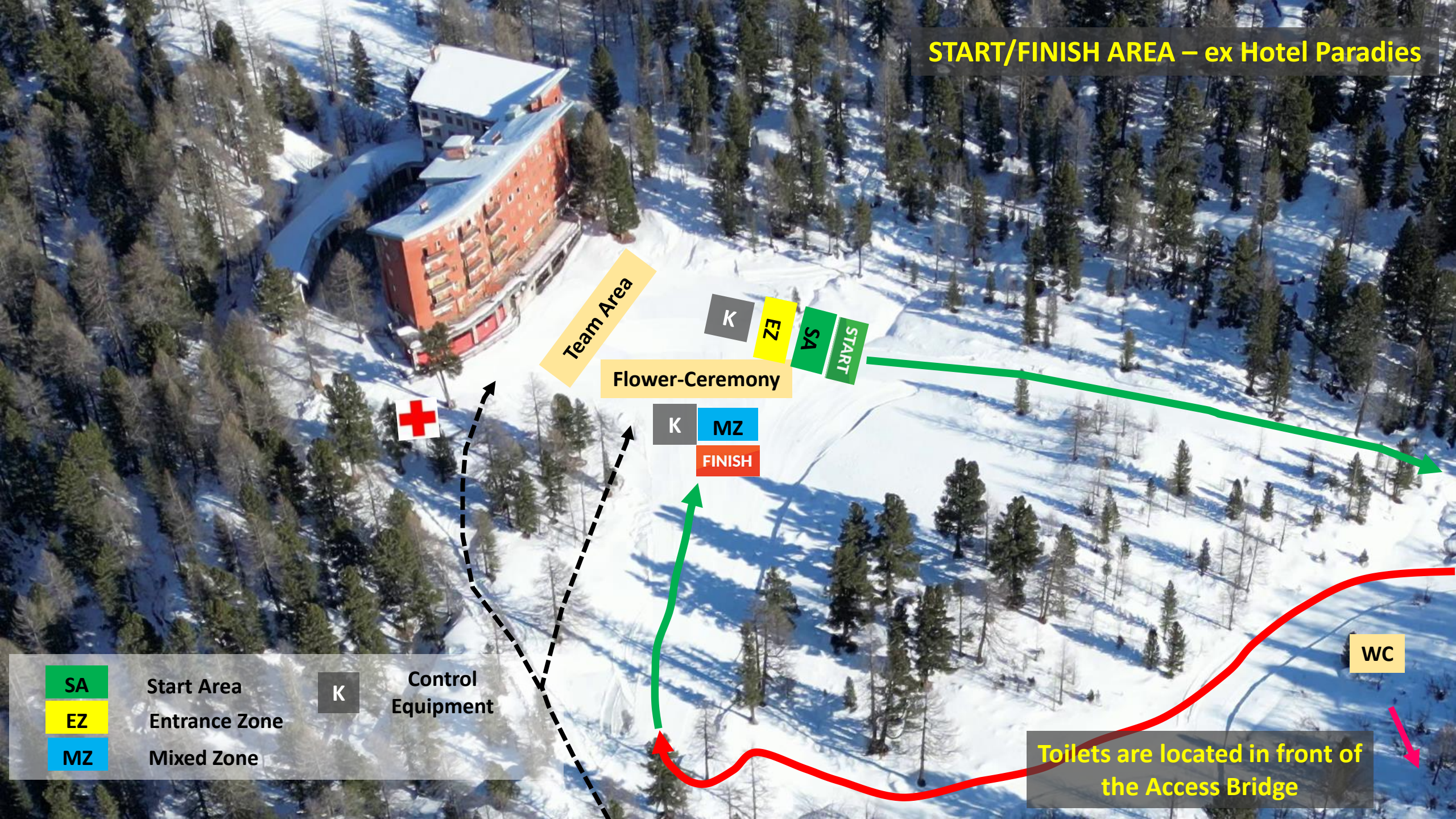

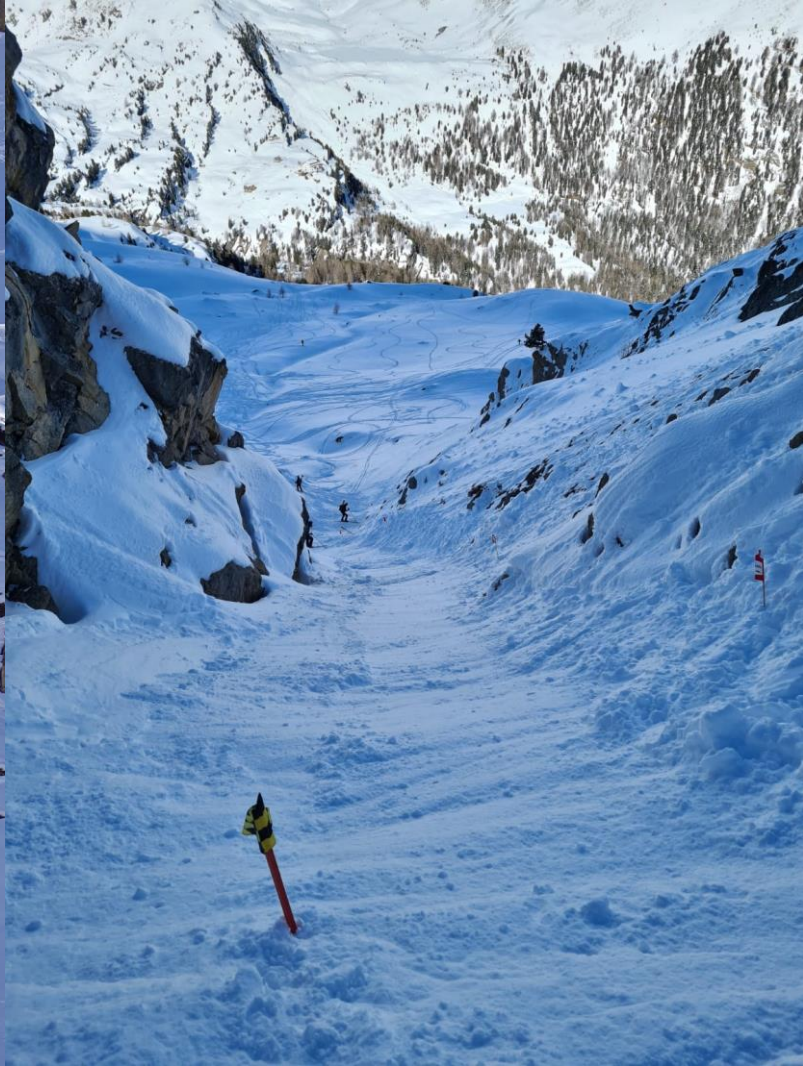

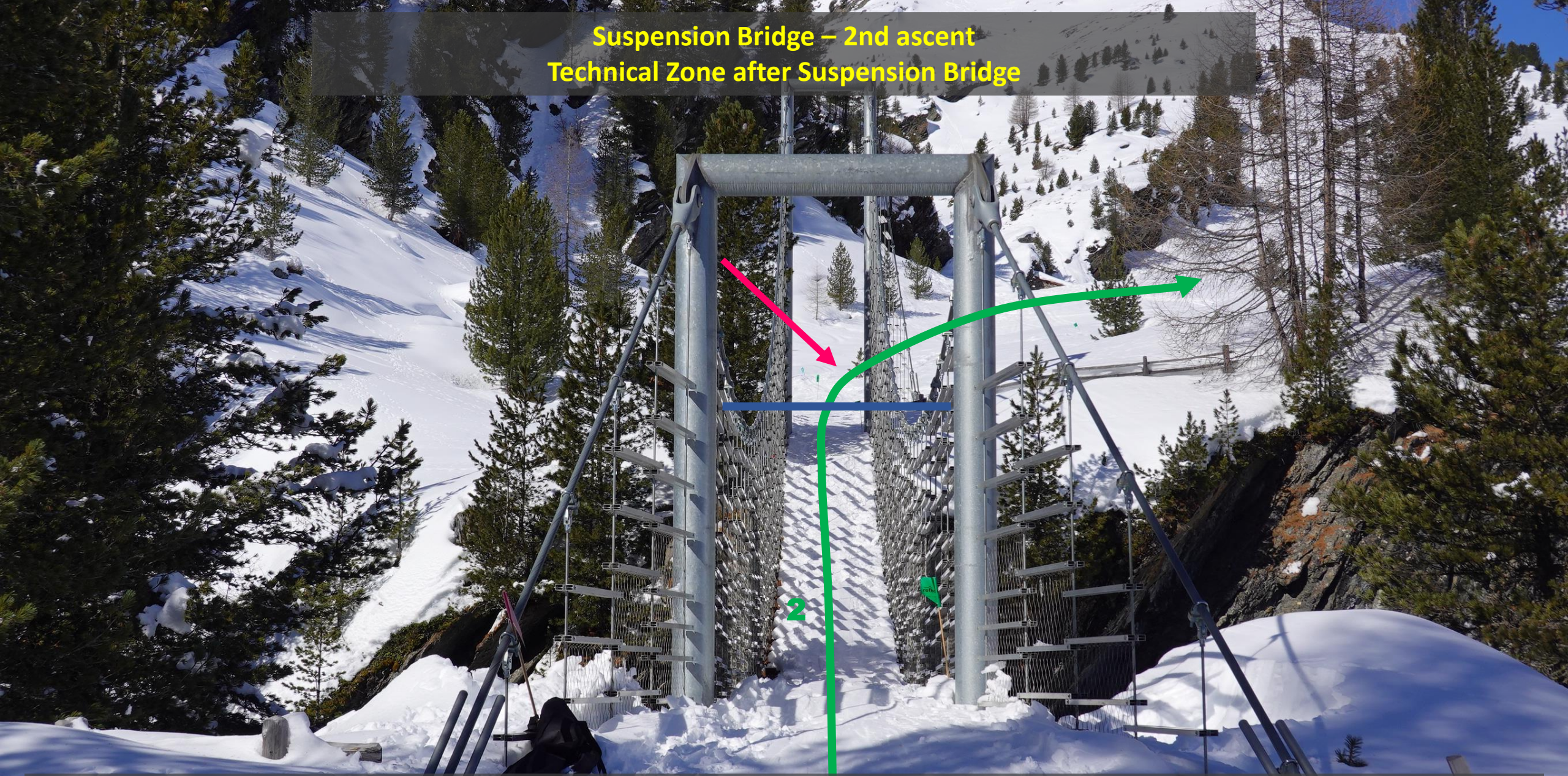

Suspension Bridge – 2nd ascent Technical Zone after Suspension Bridge



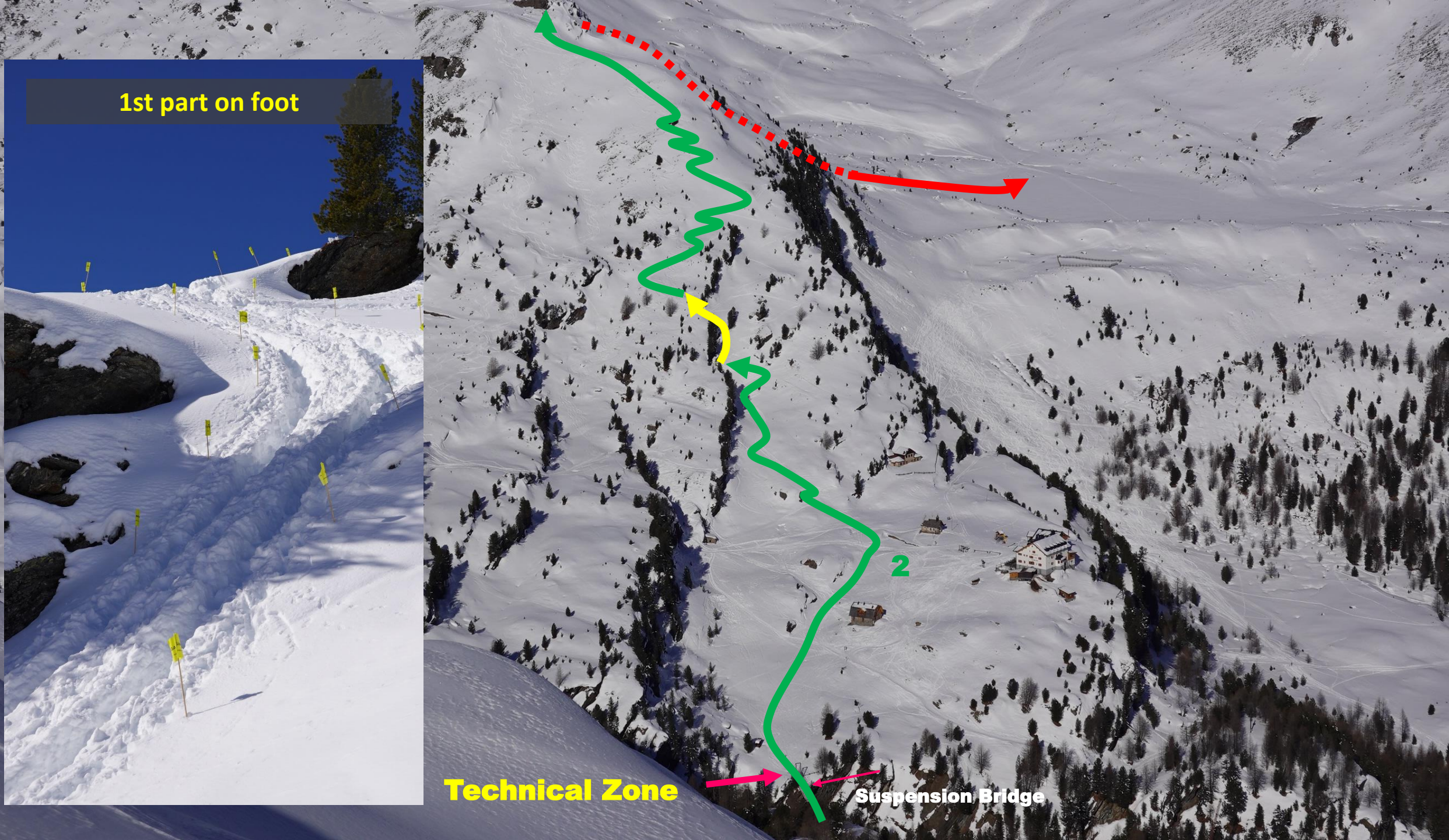
If someone has broken skis during the descent, they may pass the suspension bridge on foot with both skis in hand to the technical zone on the other side.

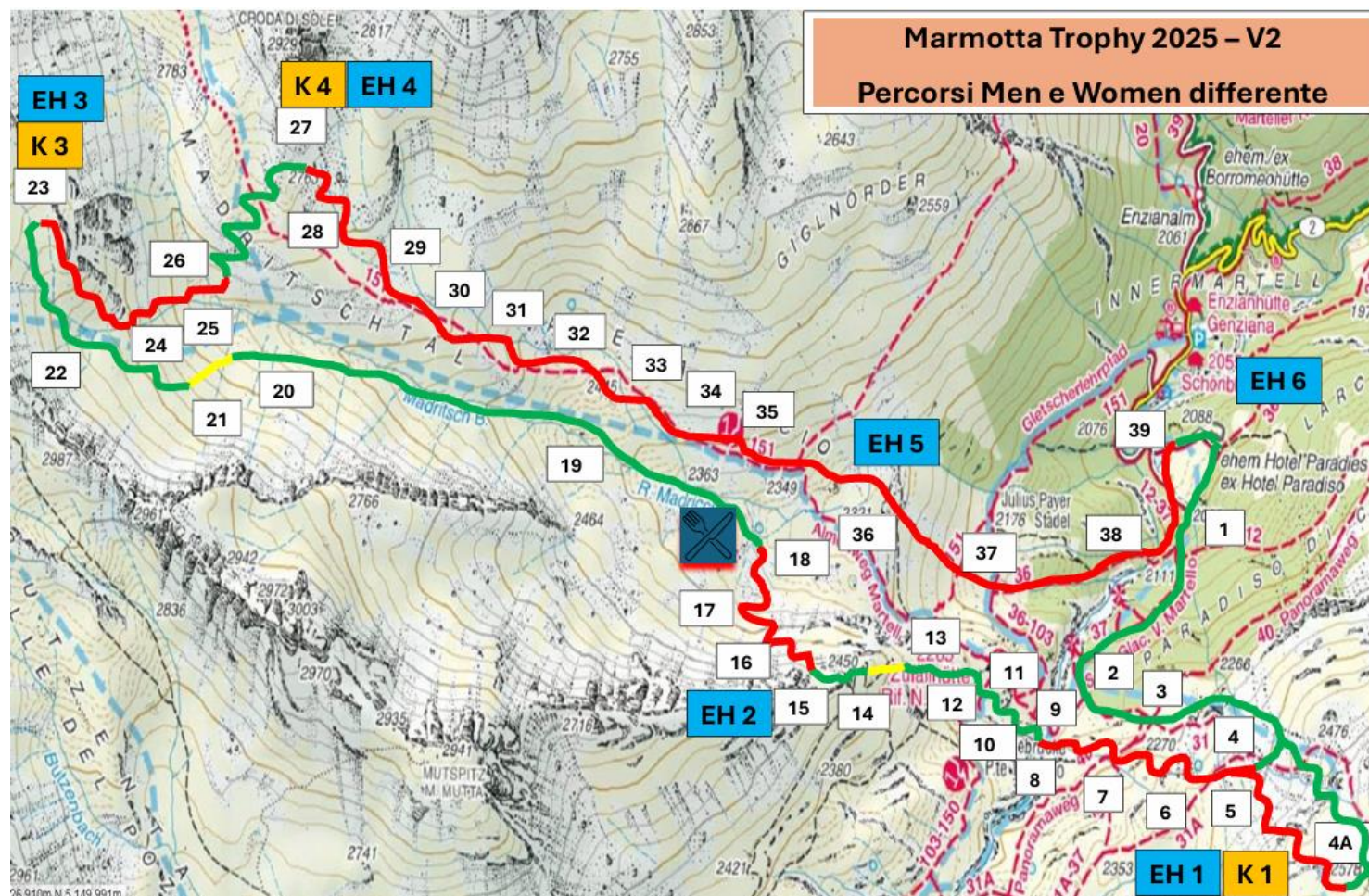
Car Pass – Shuttle Service

- Due to limited parking space, only a specified number of cars are allowed to park near the Individual Start
- Teams will get a „**Green Car Pass**“ to park at reserved parking space
- Each team will get at least 1 „Green Car Pass“. For every 8 athletes the teams get 1 additional „**Green Car Pass**“.
- The „**Yellow Car Pass**“ is reserved for ISMF, LOC; the „**Red Car Pass**“ is valid for the races on Saturday; Please make sure to park in the right area!

Safety along the Track

Safety along the route is guaranteed by 6 First-Aid Stations, 2 Avalanche Rescue Dogs and 70 Track Attendants of Mountain Rescue, all equipped with Radio! Rescue helicopter approach time, weather permitting, to the track: 6-8 minutes

RULES & GUIDELINES



Starting procedure

INDIVIDUAL – TEAM – VERTICAL	TIME BEFORE OFFICIAL START
Avalanche victim detectors and equipment are inspected.	10-20 minutes
Athletes are called to the start line.	5 minutes
Athletes are placed in starting position at the start line.	3min
The speaker will call “2 minutes until the start” in accordance with the ISMF Jury President.	2 minutes
The speaker will ask for silence. The ISMF Referees must verify that all of the athletes have placed the front part of the skis totally behind the start line.	12 seconds
The ISMF Jury President calls: “Take your marks,” Athletes must stay stationary and in position. The ISMF Referees will check that all skis are totally behind the start line.	About 4 seconds
	1-2 seconds
Start signal pistol or whistle.	0 seconds

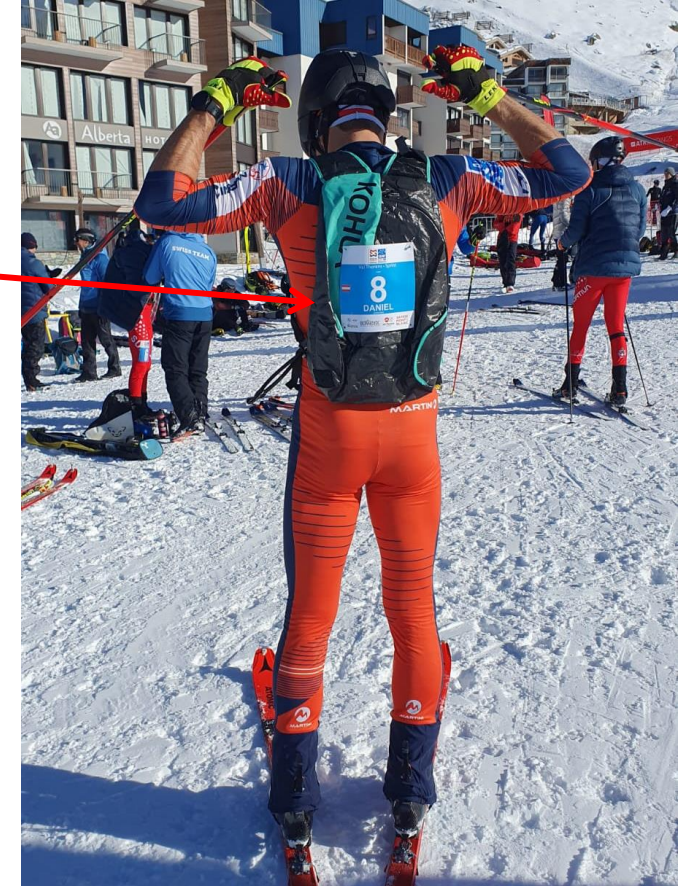
Bib and Transponders position

Case of abandon of an athlete

Abandon:

- An athlete having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give-up by decision of the LOC Race Director or one of the doctor's present.
- Giving up (by own initiative or forced) must take place at a checkpoint or waypoint according to the procedure described during the TCM except under extreme circumstances. For team races, if one team member gives up then the other will be told to give up and must follow instructions given by the controllers. Every athlete having withdrawn **MUST** inform the ISMF Jury President (or his/her representative) upon arrival at the finish area. The athletes having withdrawn may also be subject to doping control.
