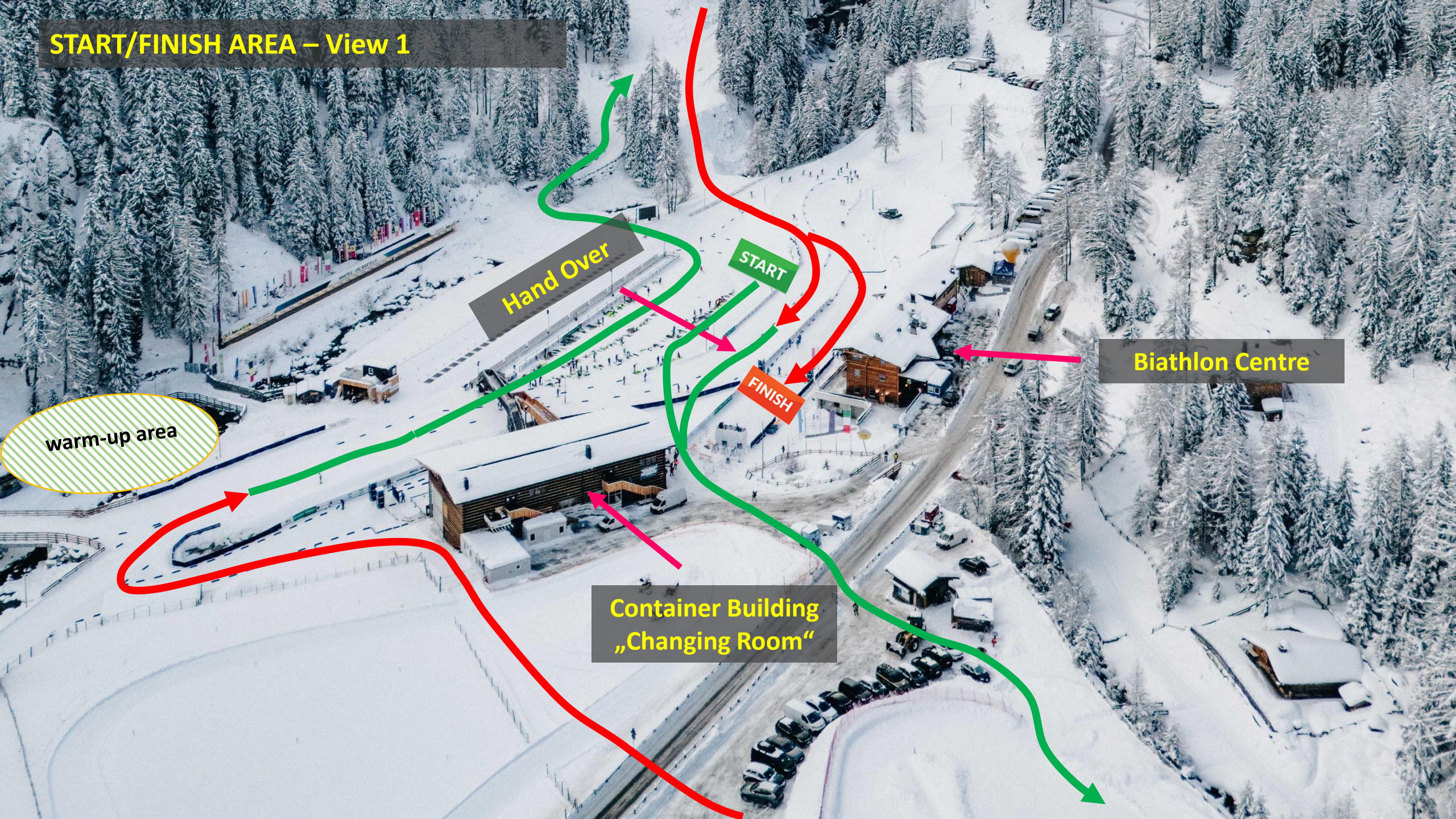

Car Pass – Shuttle Service

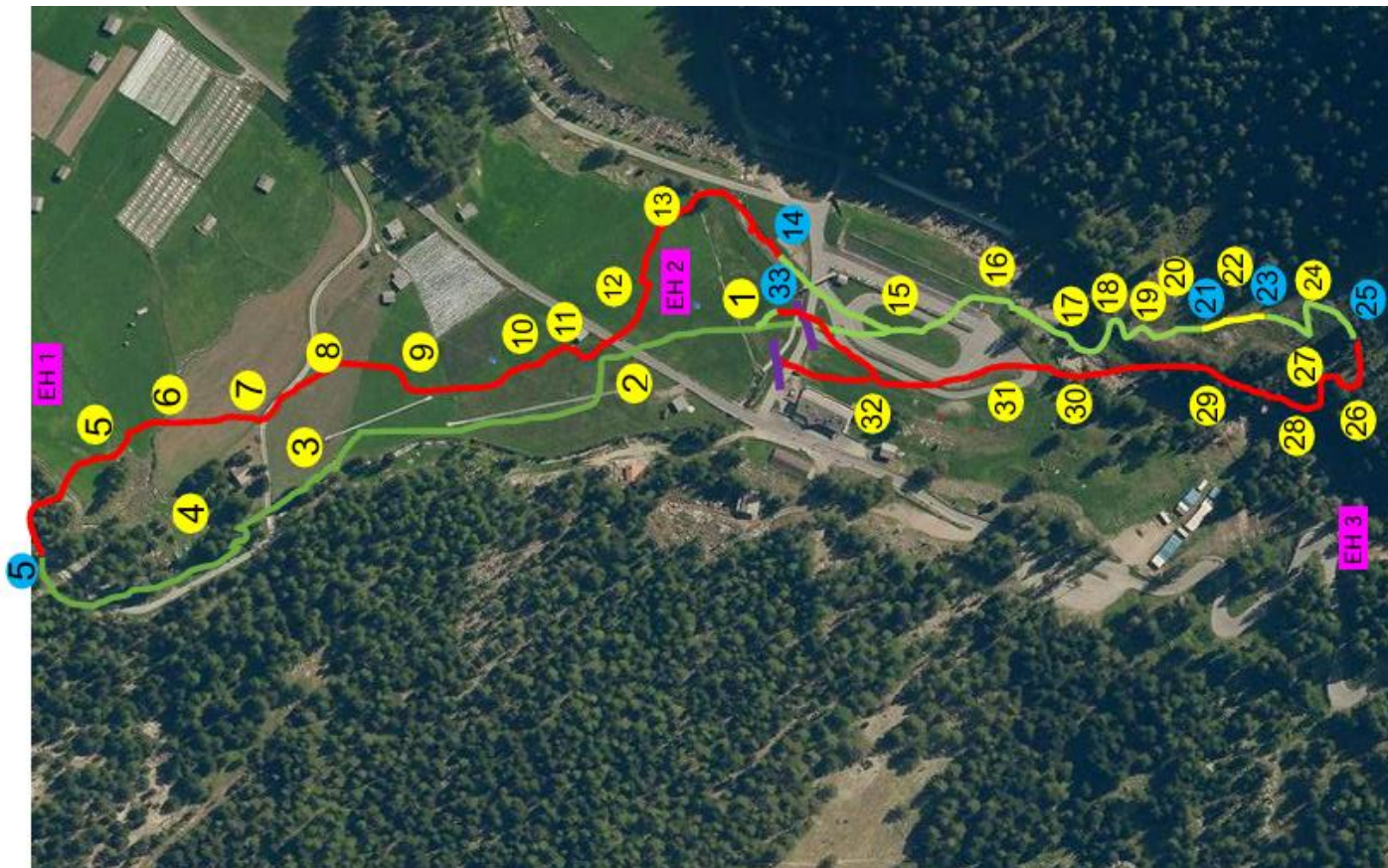
- Teams will get a „**Green Car Pass**“ to park at reserved parking space
- Each team will get at least 1 „Green Car Pass“. For every 8 athletes the teams get 1 additional „**Green Car Pass**“.
- The „**Yellow Car Pass**“ is reserved for ISMF, LOC; the „**Red Car Pass**“ is valid for the races on Saturday; Please make sure to park in the right area!
- **Alternatively, there is a free shuttle service from the Biathlon Centre (no pre-booking needed)**

Safety along the Track

Safety along the route is guaranteed by 3 First-Aid-Stations and 50 Track Attendants of Mountain Rescue, all equipped with Radio! Rescue helicopter approach time, weather permitting, to the track: 6-8 minutes



To remember...

Celebrations between teammates are only allowed after the second finish line.

Please ask the athletes to respect this rule.

RULES & GUIDELINES



Starting procedure

TIME BEFORE OFFICIAL START	SPRINT - RELAY
10-20 minutes	
5 minutes 3min	Athletes are called to the start line Athletes are organised on the Pre-Start. After this moment the entrance to the pre-start tent will be closed.
2 minutes	
12 seconds	The speaker will ask for silence. The athletes will move from Pre-Start line to the Start line and are asked to stay stationary in place. The ISMF Referees must verify that the front part of the skis are totally behind the start line.
About 4 seconds	The ISMF Jury President calls: "Take your marks."
1-2 seconds	The ISMF Jury President will call: "Set." After this command is given, all athletes must remain motionless and in their set position.
0 seconds	Start signal pistol or whistle.



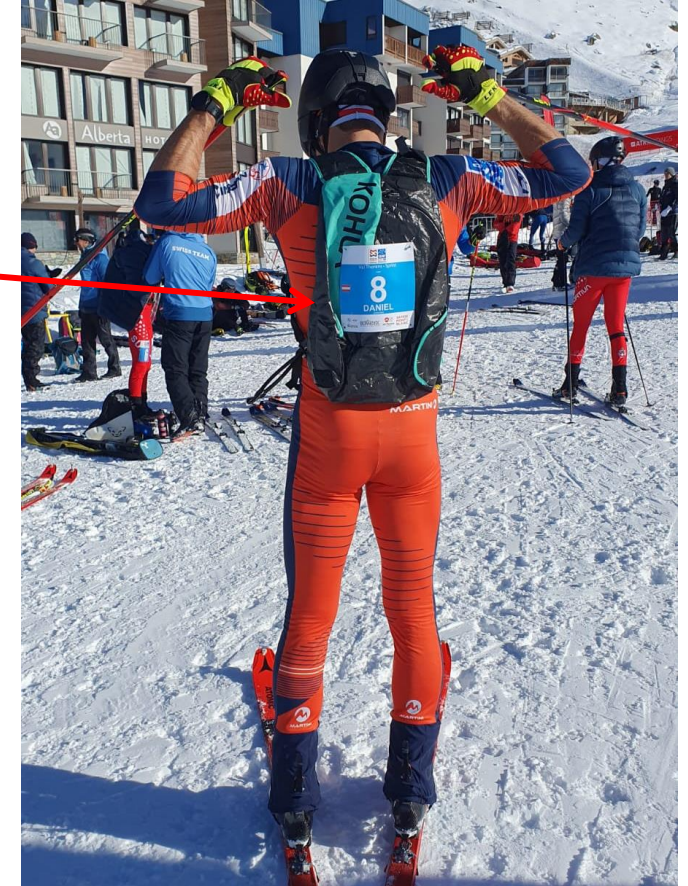
Bib and Transponders position

Case of abandon of an athlete

Abandon:

- An athlete having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give-up by decision of the LOC Race Director or one of the doctor's present.
- Giving up (by own initiative or forced) must take place at a checkpoint or waypoint according to the procedure described during the TCM except under extreme circumstances. For team races, if one team member gives up then the other will be told to give up and must follow instructions given by the controllers. Every athlete having withdrawn **MUST** inform the ISMF Jury President (or his/her representative) upon arrival at the finish area. The athletes having withdrawn may also be subject to doping control.

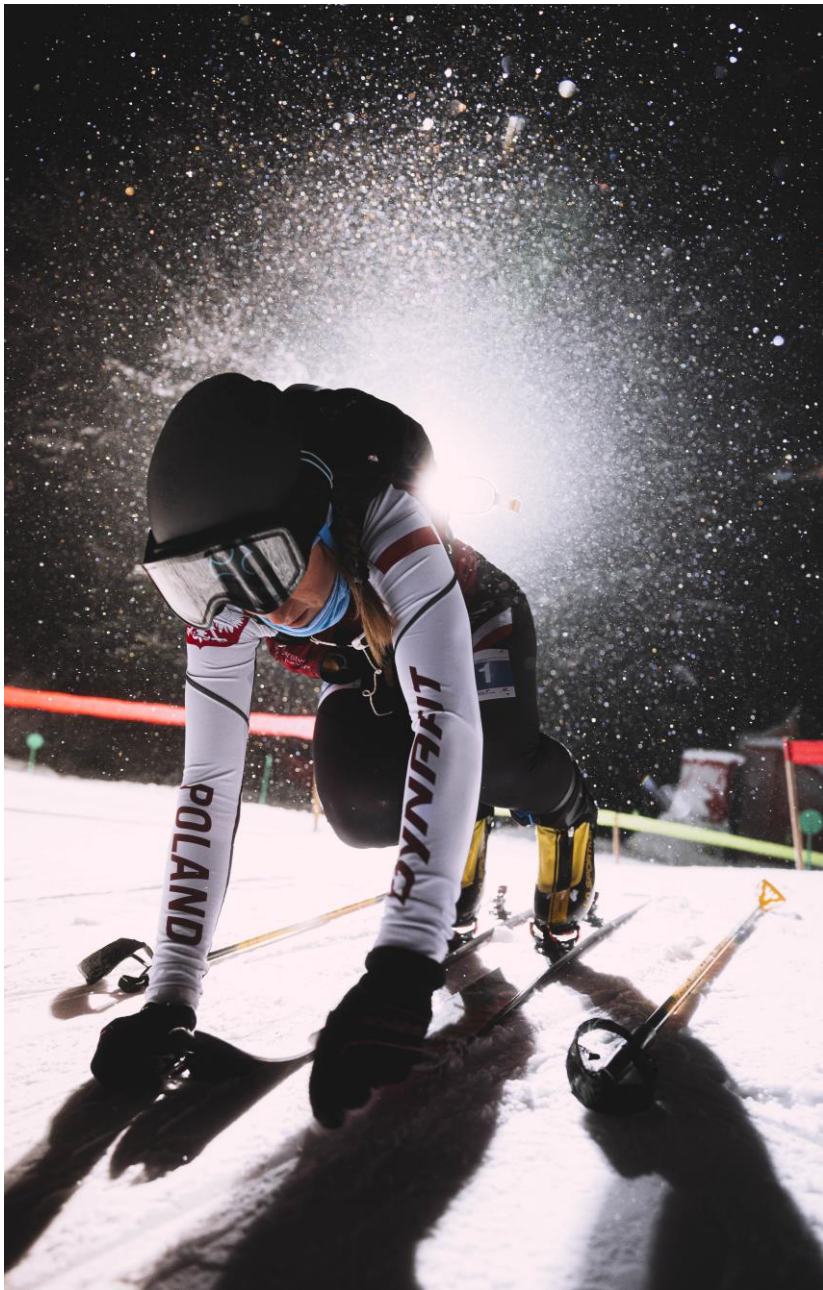
